The Project is the site development, design and construction of the proposed future Nakoosa Trail Satellite Bus Facility for Metro Transit. The proposed Madison Metro Transit Satellite Bus Facility will accommodate (20) 40-foot standard buses and (36) 60-foot articulated buses. It will include areas for bus storage, bus wash, maintenance and repairs, parts and materials, operations, administration offices and support spaces.

We are formally submitting our conceptual schematic design to the Urban Design Commission for the purposes of an *Informational Presentation*.

We are requesting a time to present our project to the Urban Design Commission on <u>March 7th</u> to obtain early feedback and direction. The preliminary street address for the proposed Metro Satellite Bus Facility is 4150 Commercial Ave.
