# By the Numbers

### WISCONSIN RESIDENTS USE LIBRARIES

- 61 million physical items checked out (averaging 1.2 million per week; 37% children's materials
- 1.6 million eBooks downloaded
- 130 million Badgerlink searches conducted

## FREE WI-FI

99% of public libraries offer free Wi-Fi

For <u>most</u> Wisconsin communities, the Public Library is the **primary place** for access to hi-speed Internet.

Wisconsin has one of the nation's largest and most active collection of eBooks and digital audio books.
