Core problem from resolution

Musicians and entertainers of color do not have equal access to performance opportunities in Madison. This is particularly true for performances at licensed, commercial venues and particularly true for Hip-Hop artists. This lack of equity leads to both artists and businesses losing money and citizens of color.
