- Retention area?
 - o Project description we are not anticipating any access from Gammon Road. We have plenty of access from Seybold Road. Will have street improved 2020.
- Concern was that we were getting back of retail facing Gammon Road but facing the on-ramp is fine.
 - o It is a 4-sided building.
- Think about where back-of-house might be. It has to be on the Beltline side. People will come from Seybold Road.
 - o We will develop with the tenant.
- The crown on the tall element looks a little heavy. Make a little lighter.
