Project Scope Proposed installation of approximately 2,500-FT of 10-IN diameter cured-in-place-pipe (CIPP) through existing deteriorated water mains located across Dane County Regional Airport. The proposed route crosses two airport taxiways and one primary runway. This segment of water main is currently valved out-of-service due to an irreparable water main break located under the east taxiway. This pipeline provides a significant east-west hydraulic connection in Pressure Zone 6E. Work is being planned in coordination with Dane County Regional Airport staff.
