> RE: Legistar #50427; Accela 'LNDUSE-2018-00013' -- Approval of a demolition permit to raze a onestory single-family residence and construct a new single-family residence at **1719 Boyd Avenue**.

Dear Ms. Dollar:

At its March 19, 2017 meeting, the Plan Commission, meeting in regular session, found the standards met and approved your demolition permit request to allow a one-story single-family residence to be demolished and a new single-family residence to be constructed at **1719 Boyd Avenue**. The conditions of approval in the following sections shall be satisfied prior to issuance of demolition or building permits for the project.

Please contact Brenda Stanley of the Engineering Division at (608) 261-9127 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

- 1. Prior to approval, the owner or owner's representative shall obtain a permit to plug each existing sanitary sewer lateral that serves a building which is proposed for demolition. For each lateral to be plugged the owner shall complete a sewer lateral plugging application and pay the applicable permit fees. The permit application is available on line at: http://www.cityofmadison.com/engineering/permits.cfm. (MGO CH 35.02(14))
- 2. The site plans shall be revised to show the location of all rain gutter down spout discharges. (POLICY)

- 3. The site plan shall identify lot and block numbers of recorded Certified Survey Map or Plat.
- 4. The site plan shall include a full and complete legal description of the site or property being subjected to this application.
- 5. The proposed single family house will face Crowley Ave. Therefore, the address of the proposed house is 1334 Crowley Ave. The existing house address of 1719 Boyd Ave will be inactivated when the current house is demolished. The site plan shall reflect a proper street address of the property as reflected by official City of Madison Assessor's and Engineering Division records.

- 6. Reduce the amount of paved driveway located within the 30 foot required rear yard setback. A maximum of forty percent (40%) of the rear yard setback may be paved and used for driveway and parking purposes.
- 7. Section 28.185(7)(a)5. requires that if a demolition or removal permit is approved, it shall not be issued until the reuse and recycling plan is approved by the Recycling Coordinator, Bryan Johnson (608-266-4682).
- 8. Section 28.185(10) Every person who is required to submit a reuse and recycling plan pursuant to Section 28.185 (7)(a)5. shall submit documents showing compliance with the plan within sixty (60) days of completion of demolition.
- 9. Section 28.185(9)(a) A demolition or removal permit is valid for one (1) year from the date of the Plan Commission.
- 10. Show the height of the proposed building on the elevations. The maximum height is 35 feet. Height is the average of the height of all building facades. For each facade, height is measured from the midpoint of the existing grade to the highest point on the roof of the building or structure. No individual facade shall be more than fifteen percent (15%) higher than the maximum height of the zoning district.
- 11. Show the covered grill deck on the site plan with the distance to the side property line. A covered deck or a deck that is more than three (3) feet above ground level may not encroach into the 4-foot side yard setback.
- 12. Include the basement floor plan with the final site plan submittal.

- 13. Madison Fire Department recommends the installation of a residential fire sprinkler system in accordance with NFPA 13D. Additional information is available at the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition website: https://homefiresprinkler.org/building-residential-fire-sprinklers
- 14. Please consider allowing Madison Fire Dept. to conduct training sequences prior to demolition. Contact MFD Training Division to discuss possibilities: Captain Jerry Buechner at jbuechner@cityofmadison.com or (608)516-9195.

Please contact Adam Wiederhoeft of the Water Utility at (608) 266-9121 if you have any questions regarding the following five (5) items:

- 15. The existing point well located outside, off of the SE corner of the foundation, must be properly abandoned to receive demolition approval. Please contact Water Quality staff at (608) 266-4654 for additional information.
- 16. A private well may have served this parcel prior to the municipal water service connection. Any remaining unused/unpermitted private wells existing on this parcel must be properly abandoned according to Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 812 and Madison General Ordinance 13.21 prior to the demolition of the property. Please contact water utility staff at (608) 266-4654 to schedule an onsite private well survey prior to demolition approval, otherwise for additional information regarding well abandonment procedures and potential well abandonment reimbursement programs.
- 17. Madison Water Utility will be required to sign off as part of the approval review associated with this Land Use Application/Site Plan Review prior to the issuance of building permits for the proposed development.
- 18. The Madison Water Utility shall be notified to remove the water meter at least two working days prior to demolition. Contact the Water Utility Meter Department at (608) 266-4765 to schedule the meter removal appointment.
- 19. A Water Meter Application Form and fees must be submitted before connecting to the existing water lateral. Provide at least two working days notice between the application submittal and the scheduled lateral connection/extension. Application materials are available on the Water Utility's Plumbers & Contractors website (http://www.cityofmadison.com/water/plumberscontractors), otherwise they may be obtained from the Water Utility Main Office at 119 E Olin Ave. A licensed plumber signature is required on all water service applications. For new or replacement services, the property owner or authorized agent is also required to sign the application. If you have questions regarding water service applications, please contact Madison Water Utility at (608) 266-4646.

Please contact Sarah Lerner of the Parks Division at (609) 261-4281 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

- 20. An existing inventory of trees (location, species, & DBH) and any tree removal plans (in PDF format) shall be submitted to the plans and Brad Hofmann bhofmann@cityofmadison.com or 266-4816. All proposed street tree removals within the right of way shall be reviewed by City Forestry. Approval and permitting of street tree removals shall be obtained from the City Forester and/or the Board of Public Works prior to the approval of the site plan.
- 21. Existing street trees shall be protected. Please include the following note on the site plan: Contractor shall install tree protection fencing in the area between the curb and sidewalk and extend it at least 5 feet from both sides of the tree along the length of the terrace. No excavation is permitted within 5 feet of the outside edge of a tree trunk. If excavation within 5 feet of any tree is necessary, contractor shall contact City Forestry (266-4816) prior to excavation to assess the impact to the tree and root system. Tree pruning shall be coordinated with City Forestry prior to the start of

construction. Tree protection specifications can be found in section 107.13 of City of Madison Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction –

http://www.cityofmadison.com/business/pw/documents/StdSpecs/2018/Part1.pdf. Any tree removals that are required for construction after the development plan is approved will require at least a 72 hour wait period before a tree removal permit can be issued by Forestry, to notify the Alder of the change in the tree plan.

22. The applicant shall provide finished grade elevations at the building corners for final sign-off.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

No interior, exterior or structural demolition or wrecking activities or remodeling activities (including material reclamation activities by the applicant or a third party) shall commence nor any wrecking or building permits be issued until the applicant has met all of the conditions of approval stated in this letter.

Please now follow the procedures listed below for obtaining permits for your project:

- 1. Please revise your plans per the above conditions and submit <u>nine (9) copies</u> of a complete, fully dimensioned and scaled plan set to the Zoning Administrator for final review and comment. Also be sure to include any additional materials requested by these departments for their approval prior to sign off. The final site plan shall be accompanied by the appropriate site plan review application and fee pursuant to Section 28.206 of the Zoning Code, and any other documentation requested herein with the Zoning Administrator, 126 S. Hamilton Street. <u>This submittal shall all also include one complete digital plan set in PDF format</u>. The sets of final revised plans or documents will be circulated by the Zoning staff to the City department staff listed above for their final approval.
- 2. Approval of plans for this project does not include any approval to prune, remove or plant trees in the public right-of-way. Permission for such activities must be obtained from the City Forester, 266-4816.
- 3. A demolition or removal permit is valid for one (1) year from the date of the Plan Commission. Where the plans have not been altered since issuance of the demolition or removal permit and the permit has expired, the Director of Planning and Community and Economic Development may, after consultation with the Alderperson of the District, approve an extension for up to 24 months from the expiration date.
- 4. A reuse and recycling plan approved by the Recycling Coordinator is required by ordinance prior to the issuance of a wrecking permit. The reuse and recycling plan shall be submitted along with the resubmittal of site plans for forwarding to the Recycling Coordinator.
- 5. The Madison Water Utility shall be notified to remove the water meters prior to demolition. This property is located in a wellhead protection district. All wells located on this property shall be abandoned if no valid well operation permit has been obtained from the Madison Water Utility. The Water Utility will need to sign off the final plans, and will need a copy of the approved plans.
