Forestry specialist receives project information provided by Developer

Forestry specialist reviews site plans referencing GtViewer, street tree inventory, Google Earth and/or visiting the project site in the field. Are all street trees identified correctly on the plan? How will new building affect the current street trees in place? How much will tree be pruned to accommodate new building? Where are the underground utilities?

Forestry specialist may contact the developer for clarification and discuss construction processes, (removals, grates, tree protection methods, tree replacement staging area, cranes, concrete pumps)

Forestry Specialist may consult with other city agencies

Forestry specialist will correct plan and send back to Developer

Developer revises plan and resubmits to forestry specialist

Forestry specialist reviews revised plan. Are revisions correct?

Forestry specialist submit comments to Parks Planning staff to include in Accella

Forestry specialist will issue street tree removal permit after project is approved the Plan Commission

If Developer requires an additional street tree removal after project approval by City, the alderperson will be notified by City Forester by email that additional street trees are requested for removal for the project and be provided a 72-hour waiting period before the removal permit is issued.

Forestry will enforce street tree protection requirements as listed on the approve plan

Forestry specialist oversees the contractor planting street trees.
