By unanimous consent, the Landmarks Commission voted to recommend to the Plan Commission that the buildings at 1314 E Washington Avenue and 123 N Butler Street have historic value related to the vernacular context of Madison's built environment, but the buildings themselves are not historically, architecturally, or culturally significant, and the buildings at 5380 Shaw Court, 2025 Fisher Street, 2017 Fisher Street, 1328 E Washington Avenue, 1318 E Washington Avenue, 555 W Washington Avenue, and 125 N Butler Street have no known historic value.
