**SUBJECT:** Citation Data for Residential Parking Restrictions

In response to Commission Member Ken Golden's May 24, 2018 email requesting information on citation data for Residential Parking Permit Program restrictions, the requested information is provided below.

Madison Police Department Parking Enforcement Supervisor, Stefanie Niesen provided the following information on the quantity of citations issued for the period of February 1, 2018 through June 3, 2018. A shift change occurred in February, which is why the data does not include information for the month of January.

## Citations Issued by Officer for 1 and 2 -Hour Time Restricted Violations (Period of February 1, 2018 – June 3, 2018)

- Approximately 17,000 citations for 1 and 2-hour time restriction violations are issued annually.
- The citation quantities noted above include both RP3 and non-RP3 time restriction violations. MPD does not differentiate between RP3 and non-RP3 time restriction violations, and they are not tracked separately.
- Assuming citation issuance for RP3 and non-RP3 restricted areas are evenly distributed based on the ratio of RP3 vs non-RP3 time restricted spaces, 75% would be attributed to RP3 time restrictions and 25% would be non-RP3 time restrictions.
