Cream City Scale, LLC is the original vendor for our Transfer Station scale purchase in 2005. Cream City's proprietary software, SCALEMASTER, is the upgraded, next generation weighing application of the RLWS 920i legacy application currently operated at our facility. SCALEMASTER is a web based application fully customizable and built to suit the needs of our organization. SCALEMASTER is straightforward to understand and operate and does not contain the extra jargon that bogs down other applications. SCALEMASTER eliminates the need to extract and convert weighing data by allowing direct download to Microsoft Excel. SCALEMASTER can be accessed from any computer or location within our network. Tech support is available remotely via VPN as well as onsite. Cream City Scale, LLC is the only authorized dealer of Rice Lake Weighing Systems products within 100 miles. Rice Lake Weighing Systems is what the Streets Division is currently using. The Streets Division is making this request in order to be able to operate just one type of scale and one software package so that all of our data will remain compatible.

COMMENTS REGARDING PURCHASES OVER \$25,000

The City of Madison has spent a total of \$4,983.50 with Cream City Scale since January 2015, all through P-card transactions each under \$2,000 for scale inspection and maintenance.
