The neighbors do not want the Locker Room to be approved to receive this 21+ Entertainment License, because of the problems the neighbors are having currently with the bar. The neighbors of the Locker Room remember them asking to install a volleyball court and a horseshoe pit, but not having loud music being played. We are unable to hear our TV programs, because the music is so loud. We can also feel the vibrations of the music inside our homes & the Locker Room plays the loud music pass II:00 PM, most the time it is 2:00 AM when the bar should be closing. One neighbor over the years have called the Locker Room to ask them to please lower the volume & was told by the person who answered the phone that the Locker Room has a right to play the music. Other neighbors have call the police about the loud & the called has been told that the doors of the bar are supposed to be closed at all times & the police have come over to the Locker Room and closed the doors for them. The neighbors want to being able to have their windows open in the evenings so we can be able to sleep better on some evenings. I know there is one neighbor that have to work very early hours & can't sleep because of the loud music being played at the Locker Room. One of our neighbor have a hearing problem and plays his music loud, when he is out in his garage/workshop, if you are outside you can hear his music, but you do not hear the music or feel vibrations if you are in your house & when your house is all closed up (meaning the windows and doors are closed). The neighbors are asking the Locker Room to work on the problem with the noise first before

asking for any other licenses for their business. Because the neighbors do not want to hear the loud music any more. One solution may be the Locker Room to install a noise barrier walls in place of the chain link fence, they have around the volleyball court, horseshoe pit & patio area. Like the ones along the most traveled roads to car down on the vehicle noise. We are asking the height should be at least two inches higher than the top of the roof of the Locker Room building. Another suggest is relocate the Locker Room, where you are surround by businesses that are no open in the evenings and weekends, then there will not be neighbors that will be affect with loud music. The neighbors are asking this loud music problem solved before the Locker Room get approved for the 21+ Entertainment License. Because the neighbors are tired of listening to the Locker Room louds music & feeling vibrations in our homes. If the Locker Room refuses to solve the loud music problem, then the neighbors are asking that the Locker Room not get approved for the 21+ Entertainment License.
