Sarah Edgerton described the staff proposal for a surveillance technology approval process:

- The proposed process is being drafted by Attorney May
- The proposed process will mirror the public nuisance notification process
- Kemble suggested that initial notifications should be made publicly accessible (on a website or database) and all alders should be notified of each surveillance tech request (via email)

Sarah Edgerton also explained the new draft definition (see Legislative File No. 52169)

- Alders requested clarity or removal of the language "in the ordinary course of doing city business"
- Alders also asked whether security cameras should be exempted this may need more discussion.
