





Medical Plan

- There will be an ambulance at finish (in the parking lot on the corner of Vilas Park Drive and Orchard Street)- ambulance is on call if they are otherwise needed.
- There will be two EMTs on call with the ambulance.
- There is a First Aid Tent manned by local hospital & medical staff on zoo grounds, centrally located for visibility & accessibility.
- Cell phones available for a 911 call if necessary
- Key staff will have 2-way radios
- Golf cart available for transport if necessary
- Several volunteers along the course to watch for problems
- There is a lost child (parent/child reunion) area near the finish line. Volunteers will be there to assist with reuniting the child with their parent.

Hydration

- Water at finish
- Water on bike path 2922 Arbor Drive (for 10K)*
- Water at the Wingra Springs parking area (for 10K)*
- Water at Zoo parking lot on corner of Drake and Randall (for 5K) *indicates that there may be changes to water locations based on approval of new routes, due to Monroe St construction.

Portable Restrooms

- 8 portable restrooms will be located in back zoo parking lot (across from Lake Wingra)
- Zoo has new restrooms that can accommodate 12 in each the mens & womens rooms, as well as a family restroom & separate nursing room (located just down from the finish line & near the start line).

Recycling Bins (Pelliterri Waste)

- 7 recycling bins will be located inside the zoo near the finish line
- Event volunteers will be located at each water station to keep the area clean

Volunteer Plan

Plan to recruit a minimum of 100 volunteers for race day. We will add more if numbers of runners that pre-register demands it.

- Volunteers at the start give direction
- Volunteers will be stationed at each mile marker to direct runners/walkers and at each place runners must turn or make a direction change, 5K & 10K
- Minimum of 10 along the 10K route; additional 8 on 5K route
- Volunteers at each water station, minimum of 4 at each
- Volunteers at the finish
 - To direct runners into chute
 - o To distribute water, keep the area clean
 - Give basic aid if necessary; water, ice, advance aid is for medical personnel only or call 911
 - o Handle crowd control
