Recommend approval of outdoor dining/seating for Grampa's Pizza between the building and the entry walk between Grampa's Pizza and Gib's with the following conditions in deference to the concerns and consideration for neighbors:

- a. A structured wall and gate with soundproofing be built, per architect James McFadden's proposed materials specifications and heights of 6 feet above the deck/patio;

- b. That the deck/patio be stepped back at least four feet from the public right-of-way;
- c. That there be no music (no speakers, nor performances);
- d. The outdoor deck/patio closes at 10 p.m.
- e. There be a capacity of not more than 16 seats on the deck/patio;
- f. There be developed a patio closing procedures checklist for staff.
