Levitan opened the public hearing.

Levitan noted that the applicant has original Frank Riley drawings of the home, which they intend to use for the construction of the addition. He pointed out that an enduring issue in historic preservation is whether one should construct something new, but make it look as if it's of a different time period. He noted that this is usually disfavored, but in this case that is what the applicant intends to do because they have the original drawings.
