

Notice of appeal of August 27, 2018 Landmarks Commission decision

Pursuant to MGO sec. 41.20, Allen A. Arntsen, who resides at 821 South Shore Drive in the City of Madison, Wisconsin, and is the alder of the 13th aldermanic district, appeals to the Madison Common Council the August 27, 2018 decision of the Madison Landmarks Commission, legistar 52415, denying a Certificate of Appropriateness for the removal and disposition of a monument commemorating deceased confederate soldiers located at Forest Hill Cemetery, 1 Speedway Road, Madison, Wisconsin, which is in the 13th district. Said Landmarks Commission decision is contrary to the public interest and the standards set forth in MGO sec. 41.18 because, among other reasons, approving the certificate of appropriateness to allow the disposition of the monument as set forth in the Common Council decision that is the subject thereof is not detrimental to the public interest and retention of said monument in its present location is contrary to the general welfare of the City of Madison.
