CDD Budget Update 10/24

The Mayors Executive Budget continued 2018 base funding into 2019 and added the following:

- 1. Increased Peer support program funding by \$300,000 to Violence Prevention contracts, resulting in a combined total of \$700,000.
- 2. Increased Immigration Assistance funding by \$50,000 to \$100,000 to be given to the current provider.
- 3. Continued funding for mental health case management at Kajsiab House (5K) along with additional funding (\$100,000) to support community programming. Allocation of the funds will be available upon approval of a plan that specifies services and a provider agency.
- 4. Added \$20,000 to provide for a Homebuyer Readiness/ Financial Literacy Course.
- 5. Set a \$50,000 base funding level for Neighborhood Center Support. This brought Bayview into NC support funding (at \$50,000) and added \$19,000 to Elver Park and \$3600 to Kennedy Heights to bring them up to that \$50,000 base level.
- 6. Added \$20,000 in funds to the ULGM Park Edge Park Ridge contract to address increased costs at new site.
- 7. Increased funding to Theresa Terrace Neighborhood Center by \$30,000.

CDD Budget Amendments at Finance committee included the following:

- 1. CDD: Increase staffing to the Beacon \$50,000 amendment passed
- 2. CDD: Community Building & Engagement \$115,000 amendment (vote: 2-yes, 4-No; did <u>not</u> pass). Verveer asked that the amendment be reconsidered at Committee recommended B List level for ½ year funding for \$57,000 (revised amendment passed)
- 3. CDD: Eviction Legal Services \$145,000 amendment passed
- 4. CDD: Worker Justice Project \$25,000 amendment (revised amendment to make it one time funding only). Revised amendment passed.

Other Budget Amendments of Interest:

- 1. Fire: Staff a 9th ambulance, revised amendment from \$658,350 to \$103,000 for paramedic services on the truck; revised amendment passes
- 2. Police: overtime for body worn camera pilot, \$25,000 passed
- 3. Police: A group of amendments was presented that focused on enhancing their human trafficking initiative. Approx. \$438,000 was requested approx. \$100,000 awarded.
- 4. Public Health: Narcan for Businesses, \$15,000 passed

Next Steps
