ATC utility forestry crews follow guidelines outlined in the American National Standard for Pruning distributed by the International Society of Arboriculture.

ATC works with the city forester and the Madison Parks Department to plan vegetation management on public rights-of-way, including streets, alleys, parks and greenways. ATC's vegetation management plan in your area will be considered by the Habitat Stewardship Committee on **Monday, Nov. 12, 2018, at 4:30 p.m.** at the Goodman Maintenance Facility, 1402 Wingra Creek Parkway, Room 103, with public comments at 4:45 p.m. If you have any concerns about ATC's plans, you may appear before the Habitat Stewardship Committee at that time.
