Proposed Street Resurfacing & Utility Project & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is planning a 2019 construction project on Hammersley Avenue. The proposed project will include street improvements including the relocation of sanitary sewer main and water main and the addition of storm sewer. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with some details on the proposed project, which includes a map of the proposed project limits. Also enclosed is a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time and location of the public hearing is on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for various items included with this proposed project, and the costs of some of those items are assessed entirely to the owner. Also enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

Fact and Details Sheet Proposed 2019 Hammersley Avenue Resurfacing with Utilities

Project Details - Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: The City will replace the existing sewer main with 8" PVC pipe (existing 6" or 8" clay main installed in the 1940s), and in most cases replace laterals from the main to the property line. In limited cases where the existing lateral is cast iron, appears to be in good condition upon inspection, and runs under a tree, the lateral will only be replaced to the back of curb. In those cases, the owner will not be assessed for the additional footage of replacement that is not completed. If you would like a full lateral replacement to the property line in cases such as this, please contact the Sanitary Sewer Contact listed at right (laterals assessable). Laterals on the north and south sides of the street will be relocated from the rear of the lot to the front of the lot to the property line. The sanitary sewer designer will send a separate letter to each resident requiring a relocation describing the process and reimbursement schedule.

Water Main: The City will replace the existing water main within the project limits with 8" ductile iron pipe (existing 4" spun cast iron main installed in 1943) and relocate/reconnect services to the new main. Services on the north and south sides of the street will be relocated from the rear of the lot to the front of the lot to the property line. The sanitary sewer designer will include information regarding the relocation process and reimbursement schedule for the water service in the same letter described above.

Storm Sewer: The existing storm water flows on the surface to Westmorland Blvd to existing storm sewer that travels through an easement to E. Sunset Court. The project will continue a new 54" relief storm sewer main from the Police Station Parcel between 4015 Hammersley & 4009 Hammersley and collect water along the street. The new storm sewer installation will help alleviate the overwhelmed existing storm sewer along Westmorland Blvd. New low points on the street will be added on Hammersley between Standish & Alden and on Standish and Alden at the Hammersley Intersection. If you are aware of any existing private storm sewer or private connections that discharge to the street from your property, please contact the Storm Sewer contact listed at right (private connections assessable).

Street: The City will replace all of the pavement and gravel base; install new curb and gutter, and replace driveway aprons to match into the new curb (curb, 4 ft. of the pavement and driveway aprons are assessable). Sidewalk will not be installed as part of the project. The proposed street width will be 24 ft. from face of curb to face of curb, which will allow for travel in both directions and parking on one side of the street. Driveway aprons constructed with the project will match your existing driveway material. Driveway widths will be replaced per the City of Madison standard detail and driveway request forms will be provided in future mailings. Disturbed areas will be restored with 6-inches of topsoil and grass seed, which will be watered as needed by the contractor for the first 10 days.

Street Lights: There are no proposed changes to the street lighting.

Trees: Terrace trees may be pruned prior to construction to provide required clearance for construction equipment. Efforts are being made in the street design to save as many of the existing trees as possible. There are four (4015 Hammersley (Ash), 4009 Hammersley (Ash), 3933 Hammersley (Ash) and 232 Larkin St. (Elm)) planned tree removals with this project because of conflicts with the proposed street. If, during the course of construction, it is determined that any additional trees must be removed, adjacent property owners will be notified, prior to removal of the tree. The trees within the project limits that remain may have the roots trimmed during construction. Terrace areas will be evaluated by Forestry for new trees or replacements following the project.

Rain Gardens: Rain gardens help to improve water quality, reduce flooding and add interest to your neighborhood. As part of the Westmorland Blvd. project, there is an opportunity for home owners to have the city construct a terrace rain garden for them at a subsidized cost of \$100. The terrace is the space between the curb and the property line, and a few terraces within this project are wide enough for a rain garden. Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Schedule: Earliest April 2019 - July 2019, Latest June 2019 - September 2019.


Water Main: An average of two water shut-offs are expected for each property within the project limits. A minimum of 48 hours of notice will be provided prior to the shut-offs. Each shut-off may last up to 8 hours, but typically lasts about 4 hours.

Traffic Impacts: Hammersley Avenue will be closed to thru traffic within the construction limits. Local access will be provided, but driveways may not be accessible at times when work is being performed in front of the driveway and while new curb and gutter and driveway aprons are constructed. Driveway closures may last up to a cumulative total of 20 days. No parking is allowed within the construction zone during working hours (7AM to 7PM), so when your driveway is not accessible, you will need to park on the adjacent street (i.e. Westmorland Blvd, Standish Ct and Alden Dr).

Refuse Collection: It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection to continue during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved.

Landscaping: Existing timber, brick or stone walls and landscaping plantings along the street or within the right-of-way will likely be impacted if it conflicts with curb & gutter or sanitary and storm sewer installation. If you wish to save any landscaping, it should be removed prior to the start of work in the spring of 2019. Stone or brick pavers within the right-of-way on or adjacent to your driveway that you wish to save should be removed prior to construction and reinstalled by you after construction is complete.
