

Proposed Changes to Routes 37 & 38

Proposed shift from Buckeye Rd. to Cottage Grove Rd.





Proposed shift from Buckeye Rd. to Cottage Grove Rd

Reasons for Change:


- stops on Buckeye/ Monona Buckeye Rd. construction eliminates parking areas at layover
- Allows for layover at dedicated curbside stop on Cottage Grove/ Dempsey
- Shifts service from low-ridership residential area to high density corridor
- Will serve expected higher ridership locations at new Pinney Library and Royster-Clark area

Proposed shift from Stoughton Rd. to Advanced Rd.



- New service to Helgesen, Advanced & Pflaum
- Will serve ShopBop call center and other expanding employment areas
- Removes current unsafe stops backing up against Stoughton Rd.

Proposed stops to close



- close 14 stops proposed to
- Average daily boardings of proposed closed stops range from 1 to 3



Proposed service removal from Dempsey, Davies & Buckeye segments






Proposed service removal from Dempsey, Davies & Buckeye segments

Reasons for Change:

- stops on Buckeye/ Monona Buckeye Rd. construction eliminates parking areas at layover
- Allows for layover at dedicated curbside stop on Cottage Grove/ Dempsey
- density corridor Shifts service from low-ridership residential area to higher
- Will serve expected higher ridership locations at the new Pinney Library and Royster-Clark area


Proposed service removal from Dempsey, Davies & Buckeye segments



Removes 3 stops – affects 6 daily boardings

Removes Route 38 service from 8 stops – Route 16 service still available.

Proposed service removal from Oakridge Ave.



Eliminates 11 stops

Affects approximately 43 daily boardings:

- Evergreen 10 boardings Miller 7 boardings
- Maple 13 boardings


Proposed service removal on Oakridge Ave.

Reasons for Change:

- Residential area with low ridership
- Speed bumps and narrowness of street cause operational **ISSUES**
- Shifts service to higher density ridership area where mixed-use projects are in the works
- Metro's Transit Development Plan recommends against routes that alternate trips between two different areas



Proposed service removal from Walter, Hargrove, Dennett & Dempsey




Trips operate on Atwood/ Cottage Grove Rd.

Proposed service removal from Walter, Hargrove, Dennett & Dempsey

Reasons for Change:

- Service moved from low ridership to higher density area
- that alternate trips between two different areas Metro's Transit Development Plan recommends against routes

Proposed service removal from Walter, Hargrove, Dennett & Dempsey



Eliminates 13 stops

Affects approximately 35 daily boardings:

- Dennett/Ring 9 boardings
- Dennett/Dempsey 9 boardings
- Dempsey/Rockwell 7 boardings
