Fruhling explained that the applicant is proposing to replace the fabric on an existing canopy and to reinstall a canopy on the walkway on the Monona Terrace side of the building. He said that there was previously a canopy in that location, and to the extent that they are able, they will use the existing holes in the building when installing the replacement canopy.

Levitan read from the staff recommendation, noting that no new holes shall be drilled in the brick or masonry. Gaffney-Ward confirmed this, and added that they would like both canopies to match, in the color black with the same Madison Club crest on both entrances.
