





Population by Block Group (2017)







Age Range by Block Group (2017)






- 29% of population in Study Area is younger than 18, compared to 17% for Madison
- Percentage of female-headed HH in Study Area is 2 times that of Madison overall (2010)






Percentage of Latinx individuals in Study Area is
 4 times that of Madison overall (2017)





Household Income (2017)




- Madison's median income is \$56,464

- Study Area's average HH size is 2.8


Housing Tenure by Block Group (2017)







- Average home value in Madison is \$266,536 while average in Study Area* is \$138,044 (56% less)
