






JAMES MADISON PARK MASTER PLAN - FINAL MASTER PLAN SCALE: 1" = 80'-0"

### Trees

- > 150 trees surveyed
- Change from 16 (December draft plan) to 12 trees (February draft plan) for potential conflict
- 8 of 12 trees are invasive, poor health, or ash
- Continue to allow neighborhood to adopt ash trees until plan is implemented

Hancock St./Hamilton St. Intersection





