

The BID requests an amendment to the street use permits for the June, August and September Madison Night Market to expand the perimeter of the event to include the sidewalks on the 100 – 600 blocks of State Street. We do not request any closure of any parts of State Street itself.

Additionally we request suspension of vending restrictions within the event perimeter beginning at 2pm – including the Gilman Street and State Streets areas. Suspending vending restrictions allows the Businesses on State Street the opportunity to use the space directly infront of their own businesses for sales and marketing efforts for their small businesses.
