Rigina MacNaughton and Brodie Birkel appeared before the TLNA Council on April 11, 2019, seeking support for a change to licensed premises for Pasqual's Cantina at 1344 E. Washington Ave. for one day, July 20, 2019. Pasqual's is partnering with Isthmus to host the third annual Margarita & Taco Fest in the parking lot behind the restaurant. The event is planned from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM. The event will be ticketed and fenced and security will be provided. Music is planned for the event, but will not be broadcasted through the neighborhood. Transportation alternatives will be encouraged.

Pasqual's responded to the Council's questions about the event and was very receptive to the Council's input. The TLNA Council voted unanimously to support the change to licensed premises for July 20, 2019. Margarita & Taco Fest has been a great success the past two years and we are confident that it will once again be a fun and safe event.
