Background

By Youth for Youth (BYFY) is a volunteer youth allocation committee that distributes funds to other youth initiatives based on priorities established by the youth themselves. This year the committee is composed of 25 students from Dane County area high schools. This year marks the 26th cycle of BYFY funding.

Three sponsors make \$26,000 available for investment.

These include:

- City of Madison Office of Community Services (\$5,500)
- United Way Dane County (\$6500)
- Dane County Youth Commission (\$14,000)

The remaining \$5,000 is held to support youth on the By Youth For Youth Committee by providing food, training, and transportation.

Twenty Five projects applied for financial support; with the requests totaling \$60,190. Most of the applicants were from within Madison, but groups in other communities also submitted requests, notably McFarland, Verona, Waunakee, and Sun Prairie. Schools, community centers, non-profit organizations and groups of individuals were among the applicants.

Priorities

This year's BYFY committee was especially interested in funding projects that address:

- Health
- Homelessness & Food Security
- Education
- Race & Religious Discrimination
- Violence & Abuse Prevention
- LGBTQ+ & Women's Rights
- Environment

The attached list of 16 recommended projects align within these priorities and will impact over 2,000 youth and their families in our community.

Action

Approve \$21,000 to projects as recommended by the By Youth For Youth Committee.
