The City of Madison is proposing to reconstruct South Point Road in 2019 from Harvest Moon Lane to Tawny Acorn Drive. Enclosed with this letter is a fact sheet with some details on the proposed project along with a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time and location of the public hearing can be found on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for various items included with this proposed project. The costs of some items are shared between the property owner and the City, while other costs are assessed entirely to the property owner. A table detailing the City's standard assessment policy for these items is included in the fact sheet.

Also enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the property owner's share of estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 4.0% interest charged on the unpaid balance.
