In reviewing the alcohol license renewal paperwork for State Street Brats, I have a few follow-up questions. It appears that question 8 was left blank. That question reads "Since filing of last application, has the named licensee or any other person affiliated with this license (partner, member, officer, director, manager or liquor/beer agent) been convicted of any offenses (excluding traffic offenses not related to alcohol) for violation of any federal laws, Wisconsin laws, any laws of other states, or ordinances of any county or municipality?" Can you confirm whether that should be yes or no?

Additionally, last year, Conrad Andringa was listed as an officer/member of the corporation. He is not listed on this year's form. Is he still a member of State Street Brauthaus of Madison Inc? If he is no longer an officer/member, a change of corporate control will need to be filed with our office.
