10.) Premises description:

The premises is a 143 room, 86,831 sq. ft limited service hotel with 4 floors plus two outdoor patio areas. The Home2 Suites by Hilton hotel will include a small, in-house market located in the hotel lobby (shown as the Home2 Market 109a on the 1st Floor Plan). The market is intended for hotel guests to purchase snacks, beverages (including beer, liquor and wine), and other sundries. The market will be located on the first floor at the front desk area shown as area 109 on the plans and will be managed by North Central Management, Inc. Alcohol will be stored in closet 103A shown on the 1st Floor Plan.
