We would like to utilize the Marshall Park boat ramp for our work, the barges will float up to the boat ramp and load or unload rock materials for shoreline stabilization. And offload materials from large landslides. No materials such as rock will be dumped on any are of the park or pavement. We have an excavator on the barge we use to load and unload the materials brought in by dump truck.

Our route coming in the park is the general entrance, we do not require the use of any turf areas.

We would like to begin the work on or about 08/April/2019 and completion would be in on or about 30/August/2019 weather permitting.

We are a City of Madison qualified contractor, if any areas are damaged we will repair or replace those areas to the City's satisfaction.
