Fractions of an acre are rounded up to the next whole acre. Please note that a separate fee schedule applies for subdivision/CSM applications and for Urban Design Commission review. Make checks payable to: City of Madison Treasurer. Credit cards may be used for application fees of less than \$1,000.
