




Oscar Mayer facility preferred

- Very cost effective when viewed at capital cost per bus, particularly when compared to new construction.
- Location does not increase operational costs associated with deadheading
- Facility has excellent electrical capacity, which can be expanded
 - Well suited for eBuses
- Its rare to find an <u>available</u> facility, suited to metro's needs, with expansion capability.

15 Acres
 Enough room for more relocation of 1101 if desired in the future
 Owners indicate these buildings will remain warehousing

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5339b Grant

- ~\$423 million available for buses or bus facilities
- We have unsuccessfully applied the last 3 years for buses
- We are asking for \$7 million from the grant program
