








 2.51-acre parcel dedicated to the City of Madison in 2000 as part of the Hawk's Landing development



Existing Conditions





Q1: WHY DO YOU TYPICALLY VISIT PARKS/OUTDOOR RECREATION AREAS?





Master Plan Process
