Bailey described the proposed signage package, which includes a freestanding monument sign, exterior building and entrance signs, cold storage building signs, and legacy signage. She noted that the proposed signage technically does not comply with the sign ordinance, MGO Chapter 31, so the project is going through the Comprehensive Design Review process. She described the applicable Secretary of the Interior's Standards, and said that staff believes the standards have been met and recommends approval of the project with the condition that the applicants secure approval of the Comprehensive Design Review for the signage proval of the Comprehensive Design Review for the signage package.

Moroder said that they have received approval from the State Historic Preservation Office and the National Park Service for the signage package, so they feel as if they have met the standards in their design.
