Applicant's Comments: Requesting the demolition of the existing Salvation Army homeless shelter. The current facility was originally a small catholic school building. The building is poor physical condition and does not meet the current homeless shelter needs. We proposing to raze the building and build a new purpose built homeless shelter on the same location.

Staff Findings: The preservation file for this property indicates that the building was constructed in 1959 as St. Patrick's Roman Catholic School. In 1987, the Preservation Planner described it as "a simple, institutional-type building of little architectural interest."
