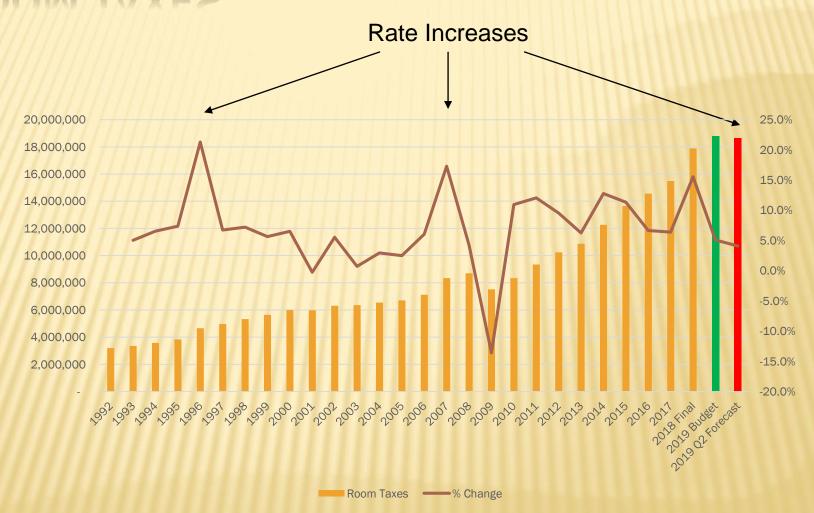

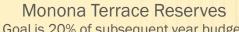

FORECAST- RTC FUND BALANCE

Average Growth	3%	4%	5%

2020 BUDGET REQUESTS

Monona Terrace

- + \$4.25 million operating subsidy (reflects \$100,000 from reserves)
- + Mayor requests an additional \$100,000 from room tax to replace use of reserves.
- + \$870,000 capital request
- Destination Madison (provide 28% of room tax revenues, per contract)
- Overture Center (requesting \$2.27 million up \$268,187)
- City Tourism Marketing Arts Programs (add \$12,500)
 - + \$2,500 for Wis Stage at Folk Alliance National Conference
 - + \$10,000 for Blink+ Temporary Art

DISCUSSION SCENARIOS

***** Assumptions:

- + \$18.8m revenues for 2019 (5% over 2018 actuals).
- + Monona Terrace at \$4.25 million (\$100,000 from reserves).
- + Destination Madison at 28% share per contract.

× 2020 Scenarios:

- + 3% growth \$150,000 deficit.
- +4% growth Balanced
- + 5% growth \$120,000 surplus
