I support the request for window replacement as the homeowners have tried in every way possible to balance historic preservation with 1) the health, safety and well being of their family which includes a child with a disability, and 2) the financial realities that they need to live within.

If you decide that you cannot approve replacement of all windows, please only request restoration of windows 1-3. That said, please be aware that the homeowners have done their due diligence by reaching out to roughly a dozen Madison and Milwaukee based restoration professionals provided by City staff. Only a handful responded at all and none would entertain providing a bid. Thus, there seems to be no viable way they can do the restoration of even windows 1-3. I realize the issue of windows is always a challenging and difficult one but, in this case, I do feel the homeowners have approached the issue in a very diligent way and are not able to proceed with any restoration for the reasons outlined above.
