

- Asked for photo simulations and more detailed renderings

























Existing Conditions



Staff Recommendation

The State Street District was determined eligible to the National Register for both its historic significance under Criterion A: Commerce, and its distinctive characteristics under Criterion C: Architecture.

Staff believes that placing additional antennas on the side of the building will negatively impact the architectural character of the Irish Pub building and the properties within the viewshed of that building along State Street.



Process

Per 36 CFR 800, Landmarks Commission needs to determine if

- The proposal would meet the criteria for an Adverse Effect
- The commission needs additional information to make a determination
- There are methods to mitigate the visual impacts, which the commission may suggest
