






### Dane County Libraries, Fine Free Status








#### Trends: Madison Public Library Borrowers, 2009-2018




# Trends: Madison Public Library Circulation, 2009-2018




#### **Trends: Factors**

- DVD fines reduced from \$1.00 to \$.25 in June 2012
- DVD and music streaming increased nationwide
- Ebook circulation increased from .3% in 2009 to nearly 10% of total circulation in 2018 (no fines); ebook usage increased nationwide
- Fitchburg library opened June 2011
- Central Library in temporary location Dec 2011-Aug 2013
- Pre-overdue notice and 7 day notice changes implemented
- We have more email addresses for patrons; more pre-overdue notices emailed out
- Fewer borrowers, fewer checkouts


#### **Trends: Top Five Fine Free Libraries**




Madison Public Library Registered Borrowers with Fines and Blocks




#### Madison Resident Home Libraries, 2019




Madison Residents
