A micro market is an unstaffed, self-checkout retail food establishment
 selling prepackaged time-and-temperature-controlled food located within a
 business.

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46 3. The annual fee for the micro market permit shall be forty (\$40) for one 47 micro market located in a building, and shall be sixty dollars (\$60) for two or more 48 micro markets located in the same building. The licensing year shall be from July 49 1 through the following June 30. The permit fee herein established shall be for 50 one year or a fractional part thereof. Renewal licenses shall be obtained on or 51 before June 30 of each year or be subject to a late filing fee of fifteen percent 52 (15%) of the license fee. Payment of the late filing fee shall not relieve any 53 person from any other penalties prescribed in this chapter for failure to possess 54 or obtain a license.

(f) Notwithstanding this subsection, there shall be no county fee for temporary food establishment operations, as defined in section ATCP 75.103(5)(h) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, by churches, religious, fraternal, youth, or patriotic organizations; service clubs and civic organizations that occasionally prepare, serve, or sell meals to transients or to the general public. Occasional means not more than 3 days during any 12 month period.

If Public Health Madison and Dane County reinspects a 2. 66 regulated business because Public Health Madison and Dane County finds a 67 violation of this Chapter, Public Health Madison and Dane County shall charge 68 the operator a reinspection fee. The reinspection fee for the food and drink permit 69 shall be based upon the anticipated gross annual food and drink sales for the 70 licensing year as set forth in the table below. of \$150 for the first reinspection 71 and \$250 for the second and subsequent reinspections. The resinspection fee 72 for a hotel, motel, tourist rooming house, bed and breakfast establishment permit: a public swimming pool permit; or a recreational, educational camp, mobile home 73 74 park or campground permit shall be \$150 for the first reinspection and \$250 for

75 subsequent reinspections. There is no reinspection fee for micromarkets. A

reinspection fee is payable when the reinspection is completed, and is due uponwritten demand from Public Health Madison and Dane County.

Plan Review Requirement and Fee. Public Health Madison and Dane 80 3. 81 County shall require an operator of a new or extensively remodeled food 82 establishment to submit equipment layout plans, equipment schedules, detailed 83 descriptions of food processing operations, and menus for review as requested. Public Health Madison and Dane County shall charge the establishment owner or 84 operator of a new food establishment the plan review fee based upon the 85 86 anticipated gross annual food and drink sales for the licensing year as set forth in 87 the table below. The plan review fee for a new hotel, motel, tourist rooming 88 house, bed and breakfast establishment permit; a public swimming pool permit or 89 a recreational, educational camp, mobile home park or campground permit shall be \$375; for a plan review and \$250 for a plan review of an existing licensed food 90 91 establishment that will be extensively remodeled. Micromarkets are exempt from 92 plan review fees.

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Fees for Special Conditions Inspections. Public Health Madison and Dane
County may charge for any inspection or consultation services that are not
directly related to Public Health Madison and Dane County's permitting and
licensing responsibilities. Public Health Madison and Dane County may charge
the operator or owner of an entity requesting the inspection or consultation a fee
of \$250.

5. Fees for Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point ("HACCP") Plan
Review. Public Health Madison and Dane County may charge a fee of \$100 for
any HACCP plan review or subsequent annual verification to the operator or
entity required by law to submit an HACCP plan for approval. <u>A separate HACCP</u>
plan review fee shall be paid for each HACCP plan.

Pursuant to the authority set forth in s. 97.615, (10) 114 Wisconsin Statutes, the fee for a pre-inspection shall be based upon the 115 anticipated gross annual food and drink sales for the licensing year as set forth in 116 the table in 46.34(6)(g)3. \$375 for each pre-inspection except as otherwise 117 provided herein. A separate pre-inspection fee shall be paid for each category of 118 permit or license. The pre-inspection fee for food and drink establishments that 119 are primarily retail and do not engage in food processing shall be \$100 for each 120 pre-inspection. The pre-inspection fee for a hotel, motel, tourist rooming house, 121 bed and breakfast establishment permit; a public swimming pool permit; or a 122 recreational, educational camp, mobile home park or campground permit shall be 123 \$375. Micro markets are exempt from pre-inspection fees.

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(11) Fees for operating without a license. Any operator of an enterprise

found to be operating without a license, shall pay to the department a forfeiture of
\$250.00, in addition to applicable fees.
