I was surprised today to see the Cap Times article by Abigail Becker which stated CGR and Acewood Boulevard ranks as one of Madison's highest severity crash intersections.

"A Vision Zero advance plan would provide safety improvements at some of Madison's highest severity crash intersections. For all crashes, these intersections include Stoughton Road and East Washington Avenue; US Highway 12 & 18 and Millpond Road; US Highway 12 & 18 and Brandt Road; Campus Drive and Farley Avenue; and Acewood Boulevard and Cottage Grove Road."

The Plan Commission will be meeting <u>at 5:30 pm today</u> to consider land use approvals for the 70-unit Ace Apartments at the NE corner of the intersection. At a neighborhood meeting in August regarding this proposal, a city traffic engineer stated that there would be no proactive safety measures implemented at the intersection.

Given that the four-story structure has only an 8-foot "side-yard" setback along the CGR frontage with a 14-foot "front yard" setback along Acewood, the vision triangle here will be significantly impacted for those traveling west on CGR or south on Acewood.

I hope that your department will consider implementing safety measures in a proactive manner in response to this development. Thank you.
