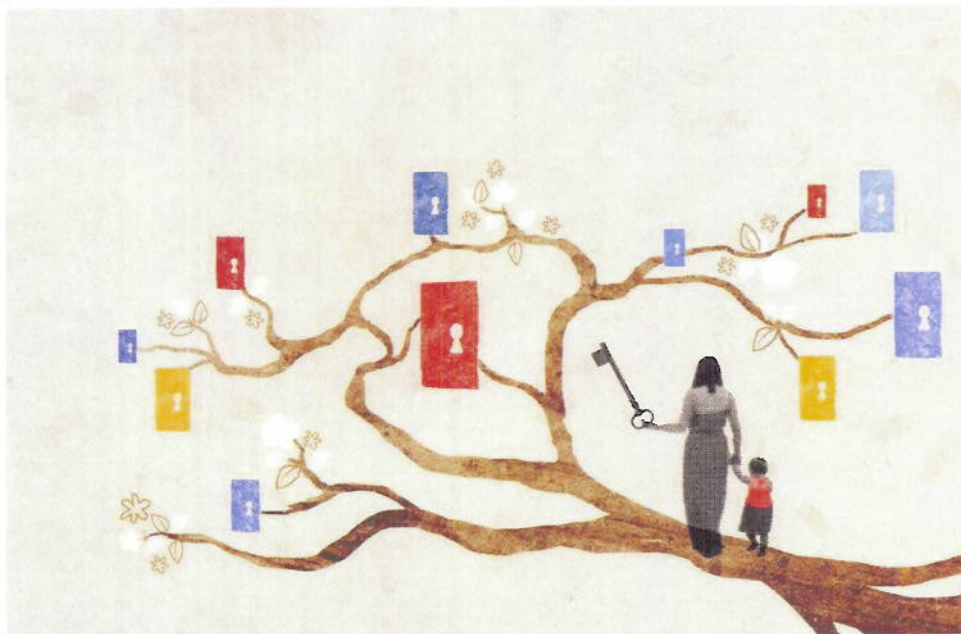


**Conversations about Supporting Young
