



Q2 INVOLVEMENT: Do you believe in city government?



Q3 Do you want to get more involved in city government?



Q4 Have you ever been to City Hall, other than to pay a ticket or go to court?









Q13 Do you need more information about your elected officials?



Q14 Are you familiar with the voting process?



Q15 Do you know your aldermanic district number?



Q16 Do you know the name of your Alder?



Q17 Today, Alders represent their district, and together, they make decisions for the City. Who do you feel/think should elect Alders?







Q23 DEMOGRAPHICS--ETHNIC ORIGIN:Please specify your race or ethnicity


