### **Action List**

1. Transportation Commission – Have fewer informational items on the agenda, and more action items, to reduce length of meetings.
2. Transportation Commission – Request policy guidance from TPPB (in writing)
3. Transportation Planning and Policy Board – Consider having subcommittees work on policy initiatives.
4. Staff – Develop a definition of 30 percent design.
5. Staff - Determine how much a project concept can change between 30 percent and 60 or 90 percent before it has to go back to Transportation Commission for reconsideration.
  - a. Review the Public Works ordinance and determine
6. Staff – Define the relationship between Board of Public Works and Transportation Commission, and submit to Board/Commission for approval.
7. Staff – Present plans (e.g. special area plans) to Transportation Planning and Policy Board earlier in the process, so that it is easier to make modifications.
