Dear Mr. Steuer;

The two-lot Certified Survey Map of property located at 2711 Waunona Way, Section 30, Township 7N, Range 10E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The property is zoned TR-C1 (Traditional Residential—Consistent 1 District). The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied prior to final approval and recording of the CSM are:

Please contact Tim Troester of the City Engineering Division at 267-1995 if you have questions regarding the following four (4) items:

- 1. Each proposed lot shall have a separate sanitary sewer lateral.
- 2. Drainage for the proposed lot shall be conveyed down a swale within the required non-exclusive drainage easement.
- 3. All outstanding Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) charges are due and payable prior to City Engineering Division sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's/ Subdivision Contract. Contact Mark Moder (261-9250) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of two (2) working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff.
- 4. The text for intra-block drainage easements per Madison General Ordinance 16.23(9)(d)2 (a. & b.) shall be included on the final CSM.

Please contact Jeff Quamme of the City Engineering Division–Mapping Section at 266-4097 if you have questions regarding the following seven (7) items:

5. Prior to Engineering final sign-off by main office for a CSM, the final CSM must be submitted to City Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final City Engineering Division sign-off. Electronic mail submittal of the <u>final</u> CSM in PDF form is preferred. Transmit to irguamme@cityofmadison.com.

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- 6. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The Developer's Surveyor and/or Applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or monument condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Jeff Quamme, City Engineering Division (jrquamme@cityofmadison.com). If a new tie sheet is not required under A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's office and shall be attached to a signed and sealed monument condition report.
- 7. Show the adjoiner information of the Lots and Block of Raywood Heights on the west side of Woodley Lane.
- 8. Correct Woodley Avenue to *Woodley Lane*. Also, label the width of the right of way west of the 66-foot Frazier Avenue as "width varies."
- 9. The plat creating the lot does not have an adequate reference to a quarter line. A metes and bounds description shall be included in the Surveyor's Certificate.
- 10. Pursuant to MGO Section 16.23(7)(d)3 and Wis. Stats. 236.21(2) (a), all CSMs that are subject to the review and approval of the City of Madison shall contain the following certificate of approval:

11. The applicant shall submit to Jeff Quamme, prior to final Engineering sign-off of the subject plat, one (1) digital CADD drawing and one (1) signed copy of the final plat to the Mapping/GIS Section of the Engineering Division either as hard copy or Adobe PDF format. The digital CADD file shall be submitted in the WisDOT County Coordinate System, Dane County Zone datum in either Auto CAD Version compatible with MicroStation Version V8i, MicroStation Version V8i or older or Universal DXF Formats. The digital CADD file(s) shall contain the minimum of the items stated below, each on a separate layer name/level number. All line work shall be void of gaps and overlaps that would cause any parcel, street or easement to not properly close. All line work orientation and geometrics shall match the dimensioning as labeled on the final recorded plat: right of way lines (public and private); lot lines; lot numbers; lot/plat dimensions; street names, and; easement lines (including wetland & floodplain boundaries).

\*NOTE: This transmittal is a separate requirement from the required Engineering Streets Section for design purposes. The developer/surveyor shall submit new updated final plat, electronic data and a written notification to Engineering-Mapping for any changes to the plat which occur subsequent to any original submittal of data and prior to final sign off.

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# Please contact Adam Wiederhoeft of the Madison Water Utility at 266-9121 if you have any questions regarding the following item:

12. Upon development, a separate water service lateral and water meter will be required to serve each parcel. The water laterals shall be directly connected to the public water main with the shut-off valve located in the public right-of-way (per PSC 185.52 (2)). A water lateral is not required if the parcel remains undeveloped.

## Please contact Sarah Lerner of the Parks Division at 261-4281 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

- 13. Park Impact Fees (comprised of the Park Infrastructure Impact Fee, per MGO Sec. 20.08(2)), and Park-Land Impact Fees, per MGO Sec. 16.23(8)(f) and 20.08(2) will be required for all new residential development associated with this project. This development is within the Central Park-Infrastructure Impact Fee district. Please reference ID# 19046 when contacting Parks Division staff about this project.
- 14. The following note shall be included on the CSM: "Lots within this land division are subject to impact fees that are due and payable at the time building permit(s) are issued." The Parks Division will be required to sign off on this CSM.

#### Please contact my office at 266-9632 if you have any questions regarding the following item:

15. Prior to final approval and recording the CSM, the applicant shall meet the conditions of their Plan Commission demolition permit approval and obtain a raze permit from the Building Inspection Division for the existing residence on proposed Lot 1 of the CSM.

# Please contact Andy Miller of the Office of Real Estate Services at 261-9983 if you have any questions regarding the following seven (7) items:

- 16. Signature block certifications shall be executed by all parties of interest having the legal authority to do so, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2)(a). Said parties shall provide documentation of legal signing authority to the notary at the time of execution. The title of each certificate shall be consistent with the ownership interest reported in the most recent title report. The executed original hard stock recordable CSM shall be presented at the time of sign-off.
- 17. A certificate of consent for all mortgagees/vendors shall be included following the Owner's Certificate(s) and executed prior to CSM approval sign-off.
- 18. As of October 28, 2019, the 2018 real estate taxes are paid for the subject property. Per 236.21(3) Wis. Stats. and MGO Section 16.23(5)(g)(1), the property owner shall pay all real estate taxes that are accrued or delinquent for the subject property prior to CSM recording, including 2019 taxes when levied.
- 19. As of October 28, 2019, there are no special assessments reported. All known special assessments are due and payable prior to CSM approval sign-off. If special assessments are levied against the property

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during the review period and prior to CSM approval sign-off, they shall be paid in full pursuant to to MGO Section 16.23(5)(g)1.

- 20. Pursuant to MGO Section 16.23(5)(g)(4), the owner shall furnish an updated title report to Andy Miller in City's Office of Real Estate Services (acmiller@cityofmadison.com), as well as the survey firm preparing the proposed CSM. The report shall search the period subsequent to the date of the initial title report (September 20, 2019) submitted with the CSM application and include all associated documents that have been recorded since the initial title report. A title commitment may be provided, but will be considered only as supplementary information to the title report update. The surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.
- 21. Add a period (.) to the end of Note 2 on Sheet 2.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division will be approved by the Common Council at its November 19, 2019 meeting.

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (attached), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in twelve (12) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
