Maintenance Manual

Overview

Upon completion of the work an endowment was formed. This endowment will be held by the Madison Parks Foundation to administer any necessary maintenance for a minimum of 10 years. This manual will provide information about the piece and maintenance.

In 2027, Madison Parks Division and Bethany Jurewicz will assess the condition of the work and the remaining funds in the endowment to make a decision on de-installation or the continued exhibition of the work.

Sculpture Information

Momental is made of two main types of material. The external cladding is formed out of Playboard HDPE plastic. The internal structure is created out of stainless-steel square tubbing.



These materials allow for both longevity and easy maintenance. The hardware used is also stainless steel to ensure minimal to no rust throughout the sculpture

Playboard HDPE plastic has a host of benefits, while being available locally at Midland Plastics in Monona. The following traits make it optimal for outdoor sculpture use.



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Cleaning (As Needed)


The surface of the sculpture is resistant to both dirt and grime. Most dirt and mud will be washed off by rain. This goes for grass clippings as well. When possible though please brush/blow loose clippings off sculpture/pad.

If dirt or other materials do not wash off in rain, warm soapy water should be enough to remove it. For any tougher cleaning jobs a chemical solution may be used, as HDPE is very chemical resistant.

Damage to sculpture or Parts

If there is any damage to the sculpture itself or parts please contact the artist, Jeff Repko, to assess the situation.

Through Momental's design parts can be refabricated away from the site and then replaced on site. Each part is catalogue and stored in the artist's digital records. This allows each piece to be remade accurately. Time for repair would depend on extent of damage. The work will be done by the artist or locally by another fabricator at the discretion of the artist.
