Page 14: Latinx used twice, Latino used largely throughout the rest of the document

- Page 19: typo in last paragraph in first column "evalutated" should be evaluated

Chapter 3 – the phrase "current preservation activities" and current preservation strategies" are both used to discuss current things being done. Should one phrase be used consistently?

Page 35 – Recommend that the callout box of "current city preservation strategies" include a reference to full list in Appendix B.

- Page 37 Extra period under 1C-ii
  - Recommend that the text be updated in the graphic with the addition of the bolded items below:
    - o 182 Locally designated parcels
    - o 7 National Historic Landmarks
    - o 1 World Heritage Sites
- Page 38: Extra period under 2B-iii
  - Graphic: 1,898 parcels in graphic but on page 37 notes 1,897
- Page 39: Type in first paragraph candid should be candidate
- Page 42 Photo caption add house
- Page 43 Sentence under 4A-ii seems to have an extra word remove "are"
- Page 48 can formatting be adjusted so text is not orphaned at the top of the second column?
- Page 49 add addresses to photo caption
- Page 51 reference to Chapter 4 in the actual chapter 4 seems awkward
- Page 52 sidebar in purple seems odd since it is repetition of the list above
- Page 53 add address to photo caption for parkway?
- Page 61 recommend that Sunset Hills be added to the list of neighborhoods covered on the near west
- side. This is a separate neighborhood from Sunset Village.
  - Paragraphs 4 and 5 on this page are repetitive.
- Page 79 Principles should not need to be capitalized

Page 82 – the terminology used to reference the Historic Preservation Plan Advisory Committee is not consistent throughout the meeting summaries.
