Title

Amending Section 11.06(4)(g) of the Madison General Ordinances to allow a license transfer with the approval of the City Traffic Engineer.

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: The current public passenger vehicle ordinance prohibits a company from transferring a license to new owners in Sec. 11.06(4)(g). This amendment would allow the City Traffic Engineer the discretion to approve an exception to the transferability subsection of the ordinance after receiving a written request. It is expected that this amendment would allow public passenger vehicle companies to request an exception to transfer a license if they are restructuring their company.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subdivision (g) entitled "License Not Transferable" of Subsection (4) entitled "Licensing of Public Passenger Services" of Section 11.06 entitled "Licensing and Regulating Public Passenger Vehicles, For Hire" of the Madison General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

"(g) License Not Transferable. No license to engage in the business of transporting passengers for hire issued pursuant to this Subsection shall be transferable - unless the City Traffic Engineer approves an exception. A licensee may submit a written request to the City Traffic Engineer asking to transfer the license. After reviewing the request, the City Traffic Engineer may approve the request if they find that it is not contrary to the public interest. Without an exception from the City Traffic Engineer, A change of ownership of a licensed operator shall act as a termination of the license - and ~~¶~~the new owner must apply for and receive a new license prior to engaging in the business of public passenger services."
