

TRANSPORTATION

Ranking Criteria (30 points needed)

- Traffic Volume—(Average Weekday Traffic)/100
- Speed—(% traffic over (posted speed limit + 5))/3
- Crash History—(Previous 3-year crashes per block)*5
- Schools—if within ½ mile, then 5 points
- School Walk Route—if present, then 5 points
- Other High Pedestrian Generators—if within ¼ mile, then 5 points, with 10 points possible
- Bike Routes—if present, then 5 points
- Neighborhood Resource Team—if forwarded by NRT, then 5 points
- Time on List—if over 2 years on list, then 2 points









- Crashes—10 points (3 points per crash)
- Fatalities—20 points (10 points per fatality)
- Access/Demand—10 points (Nearby commercial, school, bike path, library)
- Connectivity—10 points (Based on location)
- Transit Boarding—10 points
- Neighborhood Resource Team—10 points (if location is in NRT)
- Minority—10 points (≥40% minority)
- Housing Assistance—10 points (≥13% of DU)


