




# **Cannonball Path Extension**

- No consensus on best alignment & both have issues
  - Do not own all the needed property for the original alignment along RR
  - County does not currently support the path along Fish Hatchery which requires the removal of bike lane on east side




# **Troy Drive Tunnel**

- Railroad has contacted the City to apply for a state grant (Freight Rail Infrastructure Improvement Program grant, FRIIP) to rebuild the entire bridge, rather than install a ped/bike culvert.
- This was the City's original desire and would allow for bike lanes and sidewalks on both sides of Troy Dr.
- February deadline for the FRIIP grant application. An agreement with the railroad would be required.



# West Towne Path Extension - Junction Rd to Commerce Dr

- Connection to Junction Rd/CTH M Path
- Connection to path at Commerce Dr that connects to High Point Rd
- West Towne Path planned to extend from Junction Rd Path to current end at Whitney Way
- In 2020 underpass of Gammon Rd to be constructed to extend path from Whitney Way to west side of Gammon Rd



# Tancho Drive Path

- Through Park Division property - North-East Greenspace
- Connection to 151 Underpass & Sun Prairie
- Potential to use the \$186,000 from landfill fee funds for grant match
